Brandt, sending an abstract of 500 words, that should outline in sufficient detail the contents of the proposed paper, and clearly indicate the advances made. Abstracts must be received by extended deadline 1st December, 2008.

Notification of acceptance will be given before end of December, 2008. Final draft of complete papers will be required by 4th May, 2009 and will be submitted for final approval by the Members of the International Advisory Panel. Final acceptance of the papers before 29 June 2008. Proceedings will be published in hardback and will be available at the Symposium.
